DRAFT ORDER

Having considered the papers filed of record and by consent between the parties

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That, pending the finalisation of the proceedings in this Court under case number 6277/2014, an order is issued in the following terms:
 - 1.1 The pastors of the Pinville and Mohlakeng Churches, the second and fourth applicants respectively, and in their absence, the currently elected elders of each church or their designees, will remain in charge of all church services and conduct all services in those churches;
 - 1.2 The currently elected elders of the Pinville and Mohlakeng Churches will remain in charge of church board and church business meetings and all parties undertake to abide by the provisions of the Church Manual with regard to the conducting of such meetings in an orderly manner;
 - 1.3 All applicants and all respondents undertake to refrain from:

- 1.3.1 threatening, abusing, humiliating, insulting, degrading or harassing each other in any form whatsoever; and
- 1.3.2 disrupting any church service, board or business meetings, or any other church meetings;
- 1.4 All applicants and all respondents undertake to use their best endeavours to enforce these undertakings among all members of the respective churches;
2. The parties commit themselves to entering into a process of peaceful dialogue in order to try resolve the dispute within their respective churches.
3. This application is postponed *sine die*.
4. Costs are reserved.
