

**Topic is:** Feast of Tabernacles (Welcome)

**Have a blessed feast!**

*Thank you, Pastor, for that prayer, and welcome, everyone, to the Feast of Tabernacles for 2015. I am happy to see all who have been able to make it this evening, and I pray that the days to come will be a true blessing to all who are able to attend, or who are able to draw near to the Father and Son on this appointed time regardless of where they are.*

*Since the Spring Feast earlier this year, we have forgone a specifically stated "theme," as it adds fairly little impact to the various studies that we have shared, and instead have opted to let all who volunteer to share inspiration with the brethren bring what it is that they feel the Body best needs. This allows for a more free movement of the Holy Spirit, and as I have been considering the needs of the Body, I believe that the Almighty has put the word "Unity" in my mind.*

*Now, this is a topic we've covered from various angles, and at diverse times, in the past. I feel, though, that it is an area that must be improved among us if we are to walk as Yahshua walked. We have not been without progress, of course, and I noticed that Sis. Giselle referenced the S.T.A.R.S. guideline in her email.*

*I wonder, though, who could name each of the principles outlined by the letters in that acronym... We may have practiced the overall idea, but when it comes to inspired testimony, it is good to set these things before us time and again.*

*Of the Law it was written, "And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart, and thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes. And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates." (Deu 6:6-9)*

*Now, nothing that I have written or shared have been commands, except where I repeat the commands of the Lawgiver. However, what I have written, I have written in response to legitimate weaknesses in the body that needed strengthening, or legitimate areas of darkness that needed light.*

*In other words, they are important, and may well be the blessing that one or more of us need to be sealed for eternity. They may be the very thing we need to learn, so that we can speak a relevant truth to someone seeking salvation at just the right time to allow the Spirit to effectively work. Unity cannot exist where there is no communication, therefore it is my prayer that this feast we will re-commit, as a people, to being "one" in the Father and Son, and to do so by being firm as steel to Christian principles in general, and the principles of good communication in particular. Only in this will we bring forth the results for which we have been raised up as a Church. If there is one thing for which I believe our people should be praying in the next eight days, it is this.*

*Now, since I have brought up the issues of unity and communication, let me say a little word further about that in this introductory session. I will say that I, and others who serve Yahweh, do so with joy because we know His character. We know His nature, and His Personality as expressed in the Holy Spirit that He shares with all who are converted by the Gospel of His Son. Where Yah's servants are sometimes limited, however, is with regard to information. To put that another, simpler, way... we know what our Father is like, and we know who He is; however, we do not know all that He knows.*

*Because we cannot know all the factors that our Father takes into account as He works for the best good of His people, there will be times when providence – which is the outworking of Yah's will in our lives – will perplex us. There are times when we, serving Yah to the best of our knowledge and ability, will feel uncertain of our path. We will not know the movements of our spiritual enemies, nor will we see with our natural senses the results of our efforts at sowing the Word in the world. We read, "The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth; so is every one that is born of the Spirit." (John 3:8)*

*This is a very unusual verse, particularly in its placement right after Yahshua explains to Nicodemus that one must be born again. Nicodemus asks what the Savior's words mean, and He replies with other symbolic statements and then points to Himself as the One who has been sent to redeem mankind from sin. Just taking the verse exactly as it reads, we find that the Spirit moves Yah's servants to do things that may seem unusual to onlookers. Just as we cannot tell where the wind comes from, or where it goes, by mere observation, so the words of the prophets, and the actions of the ministers of Yah, may catch their audiences by surprise. And they, in turn, may be surprised by Yah's words and actions. Even Moses, one of the longest-serving ministers of the religion of Yahweh, on one fateful occasion thought to be wrathful when the Creator wished to be gentle with His people.*

*This does much, very much, to emphasize the importance of unity. One individual, working in isolation, cannot think that He has all the knowledge to act on Yah's behalf at all times. Of course, Yah can and has chosen individuals for particular ministries and actions; however, it was always His will to have all His people filled with His Spirit, working and speaking one with another, and in this way (and in no other way) bringing about perfect righteousness.*

*The Spirit of Yah moves invisibly, and sometimes in patterns difficult for the individual mind to detect. Nevertheless, we are told by Yahshua, the Person of that Spirit, "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." (Mat 18:20)*

*We may sometimes be perplexed by the actions of our Father, because He has not revealed to us all that He knows. We may sometimes be perplexed by the actions of our brethren; however, there is a difference. We know that our brethren are also acting on only that information that they have. We can ask them for the information on which they are operating, and we can relate to it. I am not saying that we are closer to our human brethren than our Heavenly Father, but there is a reason why the saved are placed in a community of human beings, and not among the angels until they are prepared for such a society. We read, for example, "If a*

*man say, 'I love Yah,' and hateth his brother, he is a liar; for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?" (1 John 4:20) John is not suggesting here that it is "easier" to love a man than our Father any more than I am; however, we can more immediately relate to our brethren because they are subject to the same limitations of knowledge that we are. This is why Yahshua's role in the Plan of Salvation is so critical, because He was Yah's experience of human limitation, of human fragility, to make Him a worthy Example for us to follow.*

*Some of you may recall that some years ago I disputed with some independent Adventists from Australia, who were convinced that Yahshua, in His human flesh, was "omniscient, knowing all things just like the Father. I pointed out that to hold this view ran directly contrary to both the Bible (which clearly states there were things He did not know until they were revealed to Him by the Father through their shared Spirit) and the writings of Ellen White (who explained that Yahshua could not, just to give one example, see what lay beyond death while He was contemplating His crucifixion).*

*Of course, they were committed to their doctrine, as many are, and so no amount of reasoning and plain quotations could sway them from their course, but it is clear from all inspired sources that Yahshua is the Father's image, pressed into our human experience so that He could truly take our place under the penalty of sin. He could be no example for the human being if He retained all the glory and majesty of His divine manifestation, and that includes continuous immortality and the immediate knowledge of all things.*

*To state all that very simply, the human experience is to be limited in knowledge, as described even in the experience of Yahshua, the Son of Yahweh. As long as we remain in these bodies of flesh, and I suspect even in the resurrected body, we will need our brethren. We were designed to exist in relationship with Yahweh, and in relationship with our fellow human beings. This is precisely why the Law is written as it is, and why it may be summed up in two covenants of love.*

*When Yah said, "It is not good that the man should be alone," (Gen 2:18) I can say with divine certainty that He was NOT speaking of Adam the mere man, but about Adam the representative man-kind, all of humanity. It is not good for us to be alone. Yah did not create us to be alone, and for all the blessings He has given us, He limited our knowledge so that we could feel our dependency on Him and on one another with every thought, if we should be sensitive enough to realize it.*

*Zahakiel : Yahshua's character is the perfect image of the Father's, yet Yahshua keenly desired the fellowship of His disciples. In Gethsemane we see this. If we are careful enough in our readings, we can see it in other places as well.*

*The Father has wrapped Himself in darkness, the Bible tells us, (Exo 20:21, 1Kings 8:12) and while He is nearer to us than anyone else can be in spirit, in mind and communication we must be very near to our brethren, or we will go off into error and loss. We can understand each other. We can relate to one another. We are required to be united with one another so that we can effectively navigate the movements of the Spirit. The will of Yah can be, even from the perspective of His*

*people, mysterious; yet, if we come together in unity and seek that will, we know that we always arrive at the truth. This is the mystery of agape; we come together in love, and we receive the wisdom of our Heavenly Father.*

*We know that all things work together for good for those who love Yah, and are called according to His purpose. I would say that these "all things" also include our brothers and sisters. You, and I, and all the other brethren, are working together for the best good of this universe. We, small as we are, move with Yah's force, and act with Yah's glory, if we do so with the unity and agreement of the brethren. If we cannot see it individually, it is the promise and assurance of Yahweh that we see it as a people.*

*I pray we consider these things. I pray we apply it always among one another. Let there be no distance. Let each of us come to this feast with an open heart, with an open mind, sharing our joys, and our burdens, our doubts and our certainties. Those who have come to the Mountain of Yah, and have gone away, did so because they cast off the blessings of which I am speaking tonight. They had their doubts, their fears, their temptations, and Satan told them that we did not love them enough, or had no power, to help. They believed him. But we do not. May such things never be seen again amongst the people of Yahweh.*

*May we come to the feast with joy, and leave with both joy and power... the power that can only be found in one-ness with the Father, the Son, and the Holy-Spirit-filled men and women that we are and have been given as gifts to one another.*

*So, once again, welcome to the Feast of Tabernacles. I look forward to sharing with you, and hearing what you have brought to share. Are there any comments or does anyone have something to share?*

**Pastor\_Chick\_CSDA\_7 : I sense the necessity for practical unity as you have described tonight. We can claim it intellectually... we can believe it spiritually... but, the practical out-working has been suffering, and much because of our distances from one another. We have lamented many times before the inadequacy of electronic communications (text, for example). I often think of the EGW statement from Letter 55 about the Church appearing to fall (but it does not). The timing for that prophecy is now, during the early time of trouble when the persecution has been intense and lasting toward the Church, but, because "the storm" has not yet come we can be tempted to fall into a condition of apathy and other like distractions including the neglect of contact, even though it is via the least desirable means. END.**

*Zahakiel : Certainly, yes. I hope that, to that end, we will still get some more volunteers to present at the Feast, and even though, as I said in the beginning, we do not have formal themes for our meetings, I pray that all that is shared will strengthen our sense of family, and encourage us to press together.*

*Any others with thoughts to share? If there are not, then let me close with a prayer.*

*Holy and loving Father in Heaven, We give you thanks for the appointed times, in which you draw nearer than ever to your people, with your hands full of special blessings that we need for the days ahead. We thank you that we have been called to come up before you, and that we will not come before you empty, but with things to share with our brothers and sisters for their edification. We look forward to receiving a spiritual meal that will satisfy us, and give us strength and energy to continue laboring for the lost and dying, and we thank you that we are those called according to your purpose, not to sit and be filled only, but to serve others with humility and love. Bless all who have attended this meeting tonight, and all who will attend in the days to come. This we ask in Yahshua's precious and holy name, Amen.*

YAH had laid on my heart a heavy burden to assist an elderly man of 86 years who lives alone. I had only talked personally to him one time, and that, very briefly but I had him on my mind for more than a day afterwards. Then, on Sabbath, he called me with a spirit of desperation. His case cannot be adequately described in words or even pictures. He had warned me that his place was a terrible mess and that he has a number of cats that he cares for. He was asking for my assistance to recover from a condition that had gotten out of hand. Well, this one was MUCH worse than I could have imagined. He told us (Barb, Daphna, and myself) that he did not want us to enter his house, and that he was very ashamed of what condition it was. Well, from the outside, it was evident that we were about to walk into a sort of "hell". The stench outside was remarkable (from the clutter and mess from 30 cats).

 Guest\_Adriel : 

 Pastor\_Chick\_CSDA\_7 : **He took us via the front door, having to make a path through weeds and such that had not been cut for months. Daphna told me today that she had NEVER seen anything like this in her life. I think Barb might still be in shock, and I admit, I totally under-estimated the magnitude of this problem. We worked about two hours in unbearable stench. Cat feces in the amount of pounds and enough garbage + feces to fill a dump truck. Sister Daphna made the bathroom sparkle, working tirelessly for the two hours, while Sister Barb and I removed bags and bags of the waste only managing to clear one large room, but not the stench. He did not take us to the other section of the house where the cats NOW live but he said it was worse. He was grateful for our motivation, and he was not just standing around either, he DID assist as much as he could but, the whole experience was a microcosm of what this world must be to YAH in its present fallen condition and yet HE LOVES ALL. In my flesh I hope Bob does not call me for another session there but, YAHSHUA accepted the "call" from a lost and dying world. He entered the feces and mess to recover whom He could and I am "proud" that two of my sisters in Christ joined me in this vivid parable of salvation. 😊 END.**
